Description

Abstract: These research activities are carried out in the framework of the project PRISMA (Promuovere Risorse Individuali e Sociali nel Mondo Accademico – Università del Benessere), that aims at promoting and supporting the dissemination of the psychological, emotional and relational well-being within the Academic community (in universities and higher education), paying particular attention to the student community, also with programs focused on preventing and avoiding conditions and lifestyles that lead to ill-being, isolation and social exclusion.

Specifically, the winner will conduct a research focused on the communication from the University to the students. The winner will conduct the research on the main means of communication used by the University, to understand which are the most effective in communicating with the students and which reach the predetermined goal. Based on the results, the winner will write a program for the effective communication of the counseling service and for the activities that aim at the students' well-being at the University.

The research may be carried out in English.

The fellowships are intended to provide the successful candidates with the opportunity to pursue their own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates for all positions are expected to hold a PhD in Psychology and/or in Communication sciences, or related disciplines.



Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar.

Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 12 month, approximately starting: **October 15th 2024**

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to **26.000,00** Euros per year, including taxes and social charges.

Deadline for submission of applications: October 4th 2024 at 12.00 noon (Rome CET).

How to apply:

Candidates shall submit:

1. The application form;
2. A motivation letter (max 1 page) along with their CV in European format, duly dated and signed, both to enclosed as a one single.pdf file ([link](#)); a declaration must be appended in the footnote of the curriculum, pursuant to the Italian DPR 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and additions, that the information provided corresponds to the truth. Moreover the candidates have to consent to the use of their personal data for the purposes of this selection procedure pursuant to the Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003 and to the EU Regulations 2016/679;
3. The attachments called “obligations and understanding” and “participation and compatibility”;
4. A copy of a valid identity document (either Identity Card or Passport);
5. (If available) Evaluation Summary Reports of Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) individual proposals having passed all the evaluation thresholds;
6. (If available) Details of Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships, ERC Starting Grants, FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/ SIR Scientific Young Independence Research funded projects;
7. Declaration on availability to held the interview in remote ([Link](#)) to be send via email at the following address: calls.fbc@unive.it , object **PROBEN Research fellowship - Communication as a tool for the improvement and promotion of the psychophysical well-being of students**
8. the possession of a PhD, with the date on which it was obtained and the University where the course was held. Candidates must also submit a copy of the foreign title with a translation in Italian or English language including marks obtained, accompanied by a self-declaration relating to the conformity to the original of the translation itself;
9. Declaration to fulfil the additional evaluation criteria listed in art. 5 according the scheme “preferential criteria”;
10. A list of the candidate’s scientific publications;
11. Copy of max n. 2 publications, to be attached to the list of the candidate’s scientific publications;
12. N. 2 reference letters, signed;
13. All documents, qualifications and publications relevant for the selection procedure (please, see the notice [link](#)).

The candidate, after the uploading, will receive a submission number and an e-mail acknowledging receipt of his/her application.

The candidate if necessary could access the procedures for updating any data and materials by the link provided by the e-mail, in any case any updates must be made no later than the deadline **October 4th, 2024 at 12.00 noon (Rome CET)**.

Please note that the University can be contacted for any support needs by the candidate until 24 hours prior to the deadline.

Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically:

For qualifications and publications, from 0 to 60;

For the interview, from 0 to 40.

Selection procedure

Short-listed candidates will be invited for the interview on **October 10th 2024 at 12:30 a.m. (Rome CET)** via **Google Meet**.

The interview will be held in English and in remote only. Further details on how to connect online will be published alongside the convocation notice.
