Temporary Centre “Project Ecosistema dell’Innovazione”

(L. 240 del December 30th 2010, art. 18, DL 19/2012; Regulations about Short Research fellowships issued under D.R. 300/2014 of 14/04/2014 and subsequent amendments and additions)

HAVING REGARD TO the Article 18, paragraph 5, letter f) of Law No. 240 of December 30, 2010, and subsequent amendments and integrations;

HAVING REGARD TO the Article 21 quinquies of Law No. 241 of August 7, 1990, and subsequent amendments and integrations;

HAVING REGARD TO Article 1 bis, paragraph 2, of Decree-Law No. 45 of April 7, 2025, as amended during conversion by Law No. 79 of June 5, 2025, which came into force on June 7, 2025, and which, in Article 4, paragraph 3, of Law No. 210 of July 3, 1998, abolished the favorable tax regime for short-term research fellowships post-graduation, establishing the application of IRPEF and IRAP taxes on such short-term research fellowships;

RECALLED the Regulation for the establishment of short-term research fellowships for post-graduate activities pursuant to Article 18 of Law No. 240 of December 30, 2010, issued with Rectoral Decree No. 300/2014 of April 14, 2014, and subsequent amendments and integrations;

WHEREAS the tax treatment of short-term research fellowships is subject to the legislation in force at the time of granting. Even if not expressly referred to in this notice, the applicable tax regime will be that provided for by current legislation pro tempore

The Temporary Centre “Project Ecosistema dell’Innovazione” of Ca' Foscari University of Venice, having regard to the Decision of the Coordinator of the Temporary Centre “Project Ecosistema dell’Innovazione” Rep. n.49/2026, Prot. n.92456/2026 of 01/04/2026 establishing the research programmes for awarding of the short fellowships in “Reuse economy and impact evaluation in organisational dynamics of a social cooperative” lasting 3 months, with the possibility of renewal within the limits of art. 4 of the Regulations for awarding university short research fellowships. The expected starting date is indicatively from **May 2026**.

The research fellowship is awarded for the purpose of collaboration with the following research programme of the Temporary Centre “Project Ecosistema dell’Innovazione” under the project “La sperimentazione near infrared spectroscopy per il sorting di Polivinilcloruro (PVC) e elastomeri termoplastici (TPE) in chiave di riciclo e riuso creativo”, Rif. 2024.0031 - ID 54329; CUP: H73C24001600007.

abstract

The research fellowship focuses on developing methodologies for evaluating the social impact of reuse and recycling activities carried out by a social cooperative. The research is situated within the experimentation of measurement tools suitable for contexts in which production, social purpose and cultural dimensions are closely intertwined, and where standard metrics prove partial or inadequate, particularly when such activities take the form of access-based practices, product life extension and service provision grounded in sharing. The objective is to develop an evaluation framework capable of capturing the specificities of the social economy of reuse, linking impact generation to the organisational configurations through which it is produced. The research analyses a cooperative operating in reuse as an organised infrastructure of access to goods, examining how its activity model articulates community orientation and economic sustainability, territorial embeddedness and service development, participation logics and organisational structuring processes. Particular attention is devoted to tensions between social mission and financial sustainability, accessibility and cost coverage, volunteer work and professionalisation, and to how these tensions shape everyday organisational functioning. On this basis, the research develops an evaluation framework integrating quantitative indicators, such as environmental impacts related to waste reduction, product life extension and resource optimisation, and social indicators, with qualitative dimensions including community building, trust and reciprocity practices, participation, transformations in consumption practices and internal organisational dynamics. The empirical work consists of data collection on the cooperative’s activities, analysis of the business model across value creation, delivery and capture dimensions, and mapping of interdependencies between organisational components. The application of the model enables linking impact metrics to organisational evolution, highlighting how hybridisation processes affect different impact dimensions and require management based on dynamic balances between different logics.

The short research fellowship amounts to Euro 7.089,00 gross to the recipient.

Rules of eligibility – Beneficiaries

Citizens belonging to European Union member states and non-community citizens in possession of the following qualifications may take part in the selection: People with **Master's Degree in Economic Sciences for Environment and Culture (LM-76)** or equivalent and an adequate scientific and professional CV are eligible.

Applicants must hold all the requisites within the call deadline. The qualifications will be evaluated by a Commission that examines the eligibility and qualifications of the candidates and makes a merit rank of them.

Skills required

- Knowledge of sharing economy organizations, with specific reference to community-driven models and their evolutionary trajectories;
- Familiarity with circular and social economy contexts, with a focus on reuse services, asset life extension practices, and community building around shared access;
- Experience in qualitative case study analysis of third-sector entities, including conducting interviews, direct observation, and integrating multiple sources through triangulation;
- Analytical and methodological skills applied to the study of social and cultural impact assessment systems, with a research-oriented approach;
- Ability to work on hybrid organizational configurations, analyzing tensions between social mission and economic sustainability and their implications for impact generation processes;
- Ability to analyze business models based on access, sharing, and reuse of goods, with attention to the dynamics of value creation, delivery, and capture.

Any other evaluable qualifications

- Experience in research activities within the fields of social economy, the reuse economy, and practices of asset access and sharing;
- Experience in research activities concerning corporate material culture and corporate cultural heritage;
- Experience in the study and analysis of hybrid organizations, social cooperatives, or Third Sector entities;
- Experience in case-study-based research projects, utilizing qualitative methodologies such as interviews, observation, and documentary analysis.

Incompatibility

The short-term research fellowship may not overlap with:

- a) other scholarships granted in any capacity, apart from those granted by national or foreign research institutes in order to integrate with periods abroad the specific activity foreseen by the work plan of the appointed fellow;
- b) attendance of PhD courses with scholarship and medical specialization, in Italy and abroad;
- c) research grants "assegni di ricerca"

Fellowship holders may carry out self-employed work or occasional or permanent collaborations, as long as this is coherent with the ongoing research, upon approval and on the condition that:

- does not involve a conflict of interest with the specific research activity carried out;
- does not prejudice the university, in relation to the activities carried out.

Subordinate employment contracts holders, in addition to obtaining permission by the university, must provide the authorization of their employer.

In the specific case that the subordinate employment contract started prior to the awarding of the fellowship, compatibility with the existing employment will have to be assessed; if the assessment yields a negative result, the short research fellowship will not be awarded; in the case of a positive result, the successful candidate will have to provide the authorization of his/her employer within 15 days.

In the event that the subordinate employment contract will start once the fellowship is ongoing, the successful applicant is required to notify this change at least 30 days before the start of the employment contract for an assessment of compatibility; if the assessment is negative, the fellowship will cease by the start of the employment contract; in the event of a positive outcome, the successful applicant must provide the authorization of his/her employer within 15 days.

The awarding of the short-term research fellowship does not imply the establishment of any employment contract, nor does it give rise to any rights of access to positions of employment at the university.

How to apply

Candidates should submit:

1. The application form;
2. Applicants must declare in the application, under their own responsibility:
 - educational qualification held;
 - the possession of a residence permit valid at the deadline of the call for applications, in case

he/she is a non-European citizen residing in Italy;

- that they understand that the short-term research fellowship is not compatible with the positions referred to in Art. 12 of the present Regulations and current legislation;
- to be medically fit to discharge his/her duties for the fellowship;
- not to have received measures restricting personal freedom at the time of submitting the application;
- not to have a degree of kinship or affinity, up to and including the fourth degree, with any professor belonging to the department or facility issuing the call or with the Rector, the General Manager or a member of the University Board of Directors and that they are aware of the provisions of the Law no 240/2010, Art. 18, para. 1, letter b);
- any benefit under L. 104/92.

3. A CV in European format duly dated and signed.

4. A copy of a valid identity document (e.g. Identity Card or Passport).

5. All documents, qualifications and publications relevant for the selection procedure.

The declarations made in the application shall be considered issued in accordance with the DPR no. 445/2000 and subsequent amendments, by candidates entitled to use the simplified administrative certifications permitted by the above decree.

Selection and Evaluation Procedure

The selection is made by assessment of the scientific-professional qualifications of the candidates, by a Selection Committee appointed by order of the Coordinator of the Temporary Centre "Project Ecosistema dell'Innovazione" taking into account, whereas possible, gender balance.

The Commission compiles a ranking and specifies the winning applicant, having regard to the score appointed to experience and qualifications, as specified by the call. In the event of two or more candidates obtaining the same score at the end of the selection, the younger candidate will be preferred.

Awarding of the short research fellowship

Having received the selection documents, and at the outcome of the checks, the Director approves, by his own decree, the classification and the selection procedure reports and makes them public.

Notification, including the start date of the short-term research fellowship, shall be sent to the winning candidate.

The winner must accept the short-term research fellowship within seven days of receipt of the written notification referred to above, under penalty of revocation. In the event of withdrawal, the short-term research fellowship shall be awarded to the next available candidate, following the order of the final ranking of merit.

Publication of the results of all the selection phases shall be published in the online University notice board, on the University website (<https://www.unive.it/data/28824/>).

Access to the selection documents is guaranteed pursuant to the law of August 7th 1990, no. 241 and subsequent amendments and additions and relative internal implementation regulation.
